

OUR RULES AND REGULATIONS - CSI 2019

Crescendo Summer Institute is aimed at singers and musicians from all over the world, mostly for young professionals and students of music academies and conservatoires. Youth Section welcomes young talents of 12 to 16 years of age.

Students are required to bring musical scores they intend to play or sing. Students are also asked to bring their own music stands if possible.

Students have to upload piano scores for the piano collaborators latest by June 10 to myCSI.

Students wishing to apply for scholarship have to make sure that they submit their application form latest by 2 June, and upload their scholarship feedback to myCSI latest by the same date. Please note that your scholarship request will be processed only after you have filled out the Feedback and have uploaded it. Since the amount of funds available to CSI is limited, the earlier you hand in your request the bigger chance you have for a bigger amount of discount.

Students are requested to bring appropriate concert attire (black dress, skirt, trousers; black or white shirt or blouse).

Participants are requested to wear their nametag on their lanyard at all times. This is to identify themselves as participants of CSI, and is also the basis of having a meal.

Participants are kindly asked to respect their fellow-students by avoiding noise in the dorms between 8 pm and 9 am.

Please note that practising after 8 pm is not allowed in the dorms.

Practising is forbidden at all times on the ground floor and the inner yard of the dorm.

All areas in the dorm and the main building are asked to be kept neat and clean. Do not move furniture, equipment, and especially music stands.

The dorm rooms will be cleaned once a week. Cleaning days will be announced, and you are kindly asked not to leave your personal belongings and valuables (e.g. wallet, tablet, mobile phone, etc.) scattered in the room on these days otherwise cleaning ladies will not enter the room.

Unfortunately there is no laundry facility to offer.

A deposit of 2000 HUF / $10 \in$ will be asked for at check-in. The deposit will be returned at check-out upon returning the nametag and dorm key.

Invoice may be requested through myCSI latest by arrival. Invoice will be handed out upon check-out.

Prior to check-out, dorm rooms should be cleared of trash and debris.

For medical assistance, on the basis of international agreements, students from foreign countries within the European Union and Switzerland are required to provide the EHIC (European Health Insurance Card). Students from non-EU countries are strongly recommended to have a valid medical insurance for tourists.
